OBJECTORS' MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION AND MOTION TO STAY ORDER

Objectors Stan Franklin and Scott Pierce move this Court for reconsideration of the Order at Entry 1403 for the reasons found on the record in entries 1404 and 1405, incorporated by reference. This motion is made pursuant to Rule 59 and Rule 60 and any other rules that could provide jurisdiction. This Court gave insufficient (zero) notice to the class that it would render a snap determination of the complicated motion that was just filed on November 21, 2023, with the only notice to the Class being that the motion was posted on the website several days after the filing date. The only reason objectors learned of it was through a chat channel. It is assumed the other class members have received zero notice. This Court granted the motion without seeking input from the Class, without advising the Class of the deadline to respond, and without any real method to object on a timely basis. No reason existed to deny the Class due process of such an important matter and no emergency existed to hear the motion *ex parte* without a fair opportunity to prepare and mail objections to the Court. If there was a deadline, this Court did not consider the three days additional provided in Rule 6(d) especially considering the non-service of the motion that occurred. This Court and Class Counsel maintain a fiduciary duty to the Class. This snap decision, and the manner Class Counsel notified the class without providing information about objecting or deadlines, breached that duty.
